### Wildfires have erased two decades' worth of air quality gains in western United States

You need only to remember last summer's wildfires in the United States and Canada, which fouled the air from coast to coast, to know the effects these blazes can have on the environment and human health.

A new study has tabulated the toll from two decades of wildfires on air quality and human health in the continental U.S. The authors report that from 2000 to 2020, the air has worsened in the western U.S., mainly due to the increase in frequency and ferocity of wildfires causing an increase of 670 premature deaths per year in the region during that time period. Overall, the study's authors report fires have undercut successful federal efforts to improve air quality primarily through reductions in automobile emissions.

# Twenty years of air quality improvement erased by wildfires



The devastating wildfires in the United States and Canada have left a significant impact on air quality and public health. Recent studies highlight the alarming effects of these fires, particularly in the context of efforts to combat air pollution.

### Toll of wildfires on air and health

A comprehensive study spanning two decades (2000-2020) has revealed a concerning increase in air pollution in the western U.S., primarily due to the growing intensity and frequency of wildfires. This trend has resulted in an estimated 670 additional premature deaths annually in the region.

The researchers emphasize that these wildfires have negated the progress made through federal air quality improvement initiatives, largely driven by reductions in automobile emissions. Jun Wang, the lead corresponding author and a professor at the University of lowa, expressed deep concern about the situation.

"Our air is supposed to be getting cleaner, mainly due to EPA regulations on emissions. However, the fires have limited or erased these air-quality gains," he stated.

# The Rising Number of Wildfires in the U.S. Is Worsening Air Quality and Affecting Human Health: New Study Reveals

Wildfires have been a longstanding issue in the Western United States, but new research suggests that their impact is far more significant than previously believed. A study led by researchers from the University of Maryland, recently published in The Lancet Planetary Health, highlights the alarming relationship between wildfires, air pollution, and public health. The findings indicate that the surge in widespread wildfires in the U.S. is leading to changes in air quality, particularly in the Western U.S., and impacting human health due to the heightened toxicity of black carbon emissions.

## Understanding the Impact of Wildfires on Air Quality

The study takes a deep dive into the effects of wildfires by using deep learning and aerosol measurements to assess changes in mortality burden attributed to fine particle pollution, especially black carbon, from 2000 to 2020. Despite national efforts to reduce human-caused emissions and legislation such as the U.S. Clean Air Act, the researchers found that the increasing wildfires have significantly undermined the reductions in fine particulate matter (PM) achieved by the Clean Air Act.

Although PM and black carbon concentrations decreased nationally, the decline in fine particles and premature deaths reversed in the western U.S. since 2010. This change has resulted in an estimated 670 excess deaths annually, emphasizing the critical need for effective policies to reduce fire risk, mitigate climate warming, and manage wildfires to improve air quality and public health.
